### PRESS RELEASE

The Traffic Committee of the Royal Crescent Society are pleased that the Avon County Council have agreed to the recommendation of the Bath City Council to enforce heavy traffic regulations in the Royal Crescent, Brock Street and Upper Church Street as from Easter next year. This is the outcome of six years negotiations. The Committee realise that this is only a first step towards a long-term solution to the unique traffic problems in Bath.
